1. Purpose

The purpose of this regulation is to specify methods for quick and effective fire response and define responsibilities of employees and other persons in case of fire or other emergency in the buildings. It complies with Section 32 of Decree of the Ministry of Interior No. 246/2001 Coll. on Fire Protection, as amended.

2. Scope

The fire alarm directive defines the activities of employees and other persons in the event of a fire. Fire alarm directive contain:

- the procedure of the person who notices the fire, the method and place of reporting the fire,
- the method of declaring a fire alarm for employees, or a unit of the company's fire rescue service or a unit of the company's volunteer fire brigade,
- procedure of persons when a fire alarm is declared (evacuation, assistance in fighting a fire),
- telephone number of the fire reporting office,
- emergency numbers.

FIRE ALARM DIRECTIVES

If you see a fire, try to **put it out**



Report the details of the fire to **112** or **+420 607 087 749**



Sound the **alarm**

- Shout "FIRE"
- Press the emergency button

the fire alarm is automatically triggered by the emergency radio after pressing the fire button



Provide **first aid**

if the disabled person's health condition allows it, ensure transport outside the fire area



Evacuate and Go to the Assembly point
